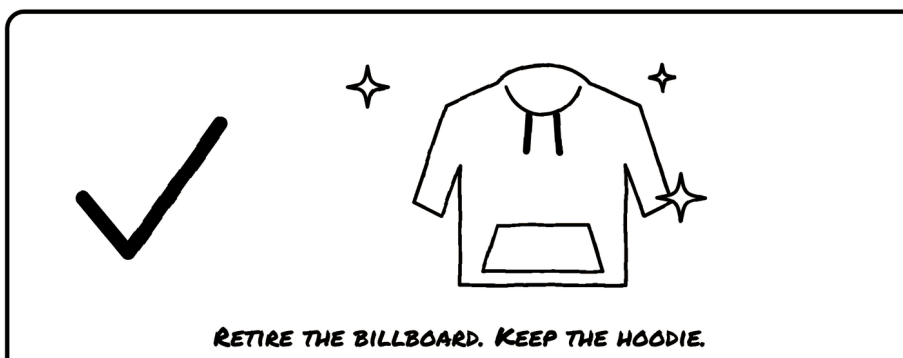
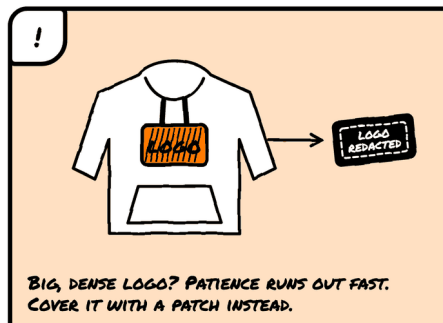
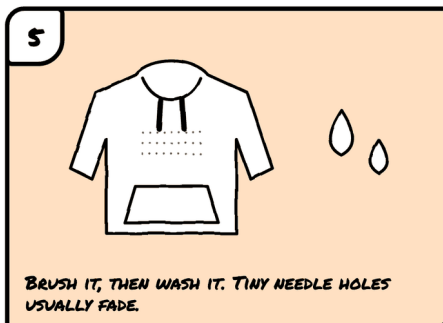
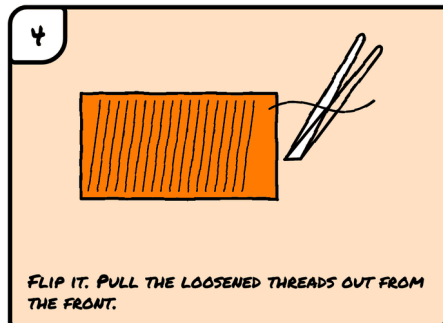
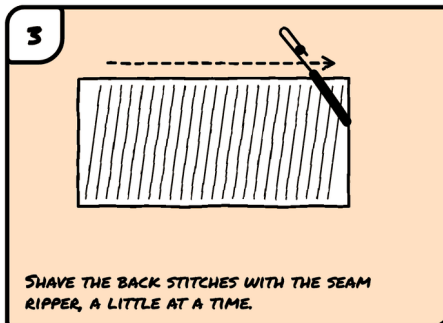
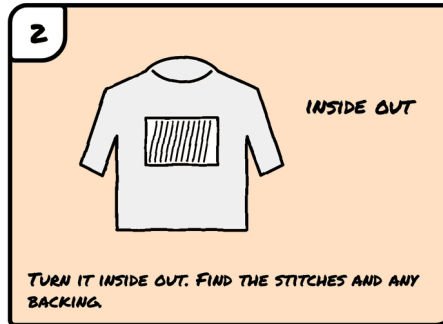
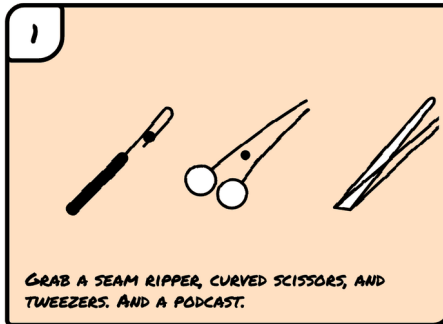
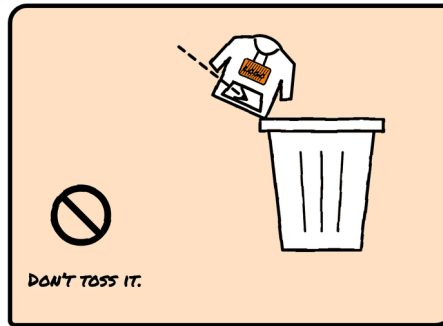
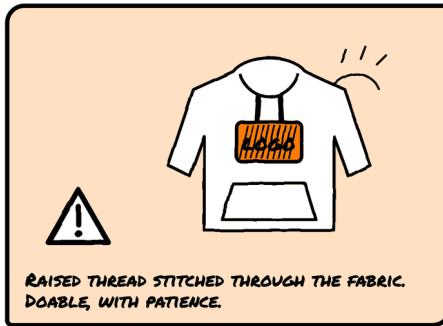


REMOVE AN EMBROIDERED LOGO

EMBROIDERY



Remove an embroidered logo

Raised thread stitched through the fabric. Doable, with patience.

Written steps

1. Grab a seam ripper, curved embroidery scissors, and tweezers. Plan on 30 minutes or more.
2. Turn the item inside out. You'll see the back of the stitches, sometimes with a stiff backing sheet.
3. Run the seam ripper under the back stitches in small sections to cut them. Go slowly so you don't cut the fabric.
4. Turn it right side out and pull the loosened top threads with tweezers. Peel away any backing from the inside.
5. Brush the area with a soft brush or your fingers, then wash it. Small needle holes usually close up after a wash or two.

Big or very dense logo? Removal can take a long time and may leave visible holes. Covering it with a patch is often the better choice.
